

## Units in Operation (UIO)

### Acceptable UIO

Vehicles within a customer's fleet which can be counted towards meeting the eligibility requirements for a FIN code. Such vehicles include:

- All cars, trucks, sport utility vehicles, or vans, regardless of manufacturer, model year, or vehicle weight/size.
- Motor Homes/RV's
- Busses/Coaches
- Ambulances
- Fire Engines
- Motorized industrial equipment. Such equipment must have self-propelled mobility and be drivable.

Examples of acceptable equipment include:

- Fork lifts
- Backhoes
- Cranes
- Tractors
- Cement Mixers
- Pavers
- Street Sweepers
- Bulldozers
- Mack Trucks
- Bobcats
- ATV's (All Terrain Vehicles)

### Unacceptable UIO

Vehicles and equipment within a customer's fleet that cannot be counted towards meeting the eligibility requirements for a FIN. Examples of unacceptable vehicles/equipment include:

- Golf Carts
- Boats
- Helicopters
- Airplanes
- Motorcycles
- Snowmobiles
- Riding lawn mowers
- Engines
- Non-motorized, attached trailers

  - Boat trailers
  - Utility trailers
